BEN

INT. IN CAR - DAY

School just ended. Kendall's mom is driving Kendall and Cassie home from school.

CASSIE

Why were you and Ben being so weird earlier?

KENDALL

What do you mean, about Tyler?

CASSIE

Yeah

KENDALL

Well you don't know this guy and we don't want to see you get hurt. What if he's an old pedophile?

CASSIE

He's not a pedophile I can tell. I trust him okay?

KENDALL

How the hell would you be able to tell? You haven't even seen his face before.

CASSIE

You don't know him like I do.

KENDALL

You don't know him at all Cassie!

CASSIE

Oh my god yes I do! Are you like jealous or something?

KENDALL

Of course I'm not jealous I just don't want to see anything bad happen to you and neither does Ben.

CASSIE

Well I appreciate your concern but I don't need you or Ben to babysit me. Thanks for the ride.

CASSIE

My mom just said she was coming to come get me, thank you so much for having me, Ben.

BEN

Yeah of course.

CASSIE

Oh I almost forgot to tell you guys, I'm meeting Tyler tomorrow.

Kendall spits out her drink.

KENDALL

You're what?!

BEN

Cassie I really don't think that's a good idea. You don't know who you might meet.

CASSIE

Yes I do! Why can't you guys be more supportive like good friends would be?

BEN

We're being good friends by looking out for you. This probably isn't the safest idea and we want to protect you from anything bad happening.

KENDALL

You wanna know what Cassie, you should go. But don't come crying to us when something bad happens.

CASSIE

Trust me, that won't be happening.

She walks out to go to her mom's car.

EXT. SCHOOL HALLWAY - DAY

BEN

Yeah I agree. Let's just hope she actually did meet that kid. I talked to my friends from the school across town and they said they didn't know a Tyler in their grade.

KENDALL

Oh god. That's weird.

BEN

Yeah.

Cassie walks toward Kendall and Ben. Her face is so pale and she's really tense.

BEN

Hey Cass how'd it go?

CASSIE

I don't want to talk about it.

BEN

Is that good or bad?

KENDALL

Were we right?

CASSIE

I don't want to talk about it
